	MB announced tonight will be his last meeting as he has decided to step down from the LOC after many years of service.		
1.	 Declarations of Conflict of Interest EO advised he has recently been appointed Clinical Lead with Primary Eyecare Services. 		
2.	 All members to check & return Col forms recently circulated by JS. Pharmacy First Update – KG All local pharmacies are completely reliant on footfall for funding, they do not have a patient list like GP surgeries. Still working to 2018 contract & finances which means a 30% reduction in income. 95% of Pharmacy income comes from NHS contract. Across L&SC alone 34million items are dispensed per year with 11k patients seen per month since the launch of Pharmacy First in Feb 2024 – deflecting workload away from general practice. Medicine supply chain shortages mean pharmacist are spending up to 12hrs per week trying to obtain some medicines. If they say they can't get it they really can't and need to ask the prescriber for an alternative. This is a global market issue. Minor ailments – Px presents to GP surgery and receptionist refers to local participating Pharmacy via EMIS without the need for the Px to see a GP. Hypertension case finding service – for adults 40 years old or over, who do not have a current diagnosis of hypertension. Will be offered a BP check when they visit a pharmacy – it is optional – results sent to GP practice electronically to put into Px record. Communications will be sent out to all local pharmacists regarding the imminent roll out of the new Tier 1 Ophthalmology contract across L&SC. 		



	Q&A Discussion		
	• There is no list available for OOS medications as it changes all the time. For IP optoms who are told the drug is OOS, the advice is to contact a local pharmacy who can look online with the wholesaler and advise what is currently available.		
	• Currently optometrists cannot refer patients to a pharmacy for a BP check, but they can		
	signpost the patient to pharmacy.		
	The committee thanked KG for her time, and she left the meeting at 19.30.		
3.	Minutes of last meeting The minutes of the meeting held 3 rd July 2024 were approved by the group. Proposed by DG, Seconded by DT.		
	 Further discussion from the group: Skin access hubs is a pilot. Currently only GP practices in this local area can access them. Clinicians should refer any suspicious skin lesions to the GP where there is a good chance the patient will be referred into one of these hubs. SA advises there is one of these hubs at the ISSA Medical Centre, Deepdale, Preston and another at Buckshaw Village Surgery in Chorley. Clinicians at BTH now have access to laptops and digital referrals. PES have been told the endpoints so all emergency referrals will be able to go through opera. No movement on having to ring On-call Dr via switchboard. They are still working on a standardised list of which conditions they want seeing when which all staff will follow.

BP & AF pilot – 12 practices in 4 areas have been shortlisted to participate in areas with biggest deprivation. Work is now being done to link them with a participating GP surgery and Pharmacy – more detail to follow. TMa is hoping to get some optometry representatives to meet with Steve Flynn (commissioner) to hear his view of the very complicated Tier 2 pathways and understand the problems they are facing.

8.	 Tier 1 There will be a crossover period. It is not yet understood whether surgical providers will be able to add patients on to Opera retrospectively if they have not onboarded by the 1/10/24. NHS111 will refer patients to the PES Hub where they will get a telemed appointment within 4hrs. If an in-practice appointment is needed, PES will ring local practices to find availability. All the funding will be passed onto the receiving practice. This is a low volume pathway. TB will circulate a contact list for surgical providers should practices need to request post op cataracts be added to Opera. EOI is going out to the mailing list tomorrow for another round of WOPEC Glaucoma OSCEs.
